

## Letter to Mitzpe Ramot Membership

Regarding: The Tax Authority's New Digital Donations System

A few months ago, the Tax Authority of Israel introduced a new approach regarding the processing of charitable tax receipts. As part of the Tax Authority's effort to improve public service and maximize taxpayer rights, the Digital Donations System (DDS) was established. This system, which was launched January 1, 2026, requires all charitable institutions (Amutot) with a Seif 46 permit, to directly issue details of donations that they receive to the Tax Authority's database (DDS). This will streamline the process for donors of benefiting from tax credits from their donations to Amutot.

Donors will no longer have to save paper charitable receipts as the donations will be saved in the donor's personal area of the Tax Authority's website. This will save the donor the need to manually present or upload the original receipts in order to receive a credit against income.
